From today's Gospel reading:


My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord. My spirit rejoices in God my Savior. God has filled the hungry with good things, and the rich God has sent away empty.

Reflection:

Mary proclaims God's greatness – for though she is "lowly," the Spirit of God has come upon her for a special mission. She will give birth to the savior, but even before this happens, she is already responding to her call as she announces what God has done for her and will do for the poor who have turned to God for help. When the Spirit of God comes upon someone, like Isaiah and Mary, they cannot keep the news of God's goodness to themselves, they must go and proclaim it to others.

So, we ask ourselves:

- How does my life proclaim the greatness of God?
- How can I share the goodness of God with others, especially the most needy


