



Feast of the Holy Family (B) December 31, 2023

Gen. 15: 1-6; 21:1-3; Psalm 105; Hebrews 11: 8, 11-12, 17-19; Luke 2: 22-40

From today's Gospel reading:

There was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon. This man was righteous and devout, awaiting the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him. There was a prophetess, Anna. She never left the temple but worshiped night and day with fasting and prayer.

Reflection:

Simeon and Anna were vigilant in prayer and watching – waiting for God to enter their lives. They were wide awake and receptive to something new and unexpected. God is there in surprising ways for those with open minds and hearts. Like Simeon and Anna, those who have put their hope in God will recognize the messiah when at last the Christ does come.

Feast Day Celebration of Santo Niño

Join the Filipino Community in Prayer and Celebration! Saturday, January 13th 9:00 a.m. Mass.

Ordinarily, we celebrate the Fiesta of Santo Niño in the Philippines on the third Sunday of January. In Cebu, people come from all over to celebrate the Sinulog. The celebration of the Santo Niño has a special significance in Cebu because of its historical background. This celebration marks the birth of Christianity in the Philippines.

The original statue of Santo Niño was given in April 1521 by the Portuguese explorer Ferdinand Magellan as a baptismal gift to Queen Juana (Hara Amihan, wife of native chieftain Humabon) upon her conversion to Christianity. It was a statue similar to the Infant Jesus of Prague.
