Greetings and Happy Palm Sunday! Astonishingly, Holy Week is upon us, bringing a flurry of activities and spiritual reflections. Please take note of the Holy Week schedule below:

Reconciliation Monday & The Diocesan Pilgrimage, March 25, 2024: Immaculate Heart of Mary Church is honored to host a full-day program for the Diocesan Lenten Pilgrimage. Further details can be found in the bulletin. We encourage all members of our community to extend invitations to friends, neighbors, and family, inviting them to experience the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

Holy Thursday, March 28, 2024: At 7:30 p.m., we will gather for the Washing of the Feet, followed by a Eucharistic procession to the repository. The church will remain open until midnight, providing prayer and reflection opportunities.

Good Friday, March 29, 2024: Join us at 12:00 Noon for the Outdoor Stations of the Cross. Volunteers are needed to help carry the crosses. Following this, at 3:00 p.m., we will observe the Passion of Jesus Christ service, including individual veneration of the Cross and distribution of Holy Communion.


Easter Vigil, Saturday, March 30, 2024: The celebration commences at 8:00 p.m. with the lighting of the Paschal Candle at the church door. Congregational candles will be distributed and lit according to liturgical norms, followed by a procession to the font and the distribution of Holy Water.

Easter Sunday, March 31, 2024: Join us for Easter Sunday Masses at 8:45 a.m., 11:45 a.m., and 4:30 p.m. (Urdu). Following each Mass, there will be an Easter Egg Hunt. All are welcome to participate in this joyful celebration of the Resurrection!
