On Saturday, October 19, 2024, at 11:00 AM, Bishop Raymond Chappetto will administer the Sacrament of Confirmation to our confirmands. Please keep them in your prayers as they prepare for this important day of receiving the Holy Spirit and deepening their faith.

IHM Rosary Society Illuminated Rosary






